Start your sentence with a capital letter, uses spaces between your words and a period to end your sentence. Read your sentence to someone.

Have an adult measure you with a piece of yarn from your head to your toe. Use the yarn to find objects in your house that are longer, shorter and the same length as you. Have fun!!! Language Arts- Sammy Snake begins with the letter s. Can you think of 6 words that begin with the letter "s"? Draw a picture of each object and try and spell the words on your own. Remember only print the letter sounds you hear. If you only hear the beginning sound in sun as "s" and the ending sound as "n" then just print sn for the word. Practice making the letter "s" in the sand or on

Math- Measurement Activity. The reticulated python is the longest snake in the world. It is 32 feet (10 meters) long. It is almost the length of a school bus. WOW! Go outside and measure your driveway. Is your driveway longer or shorter than this snake? If you were to use the string that is the length of you, how many of these strings would it take to be the length of this snake?
