<p><b>Writing/Art – Main Idea – Mother’s Day- All About Mom</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a poster for your mom or grandmother.</li> <li>• There are template ideas added to the site or you can create your own.</li> <li>• Talk with your mom first and ask her about her favourite things or the things she likes to do.</li> <li>• Make your own poster using the information you gathered or fill in the information and ideas on one of the posters on the site for mom or grandma.</li> <li>• Remember to begin and end sentences the right way.</li> <li>• Decorate and colour the poster. Add good details. Give it to mom or grandma for Mother’s Day.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Math – Skip Counting/Exercise – Can Do Outside</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Count by 5s to 100 while you skip with or without a rope.</li> <li>• Count by 10s starting at 4 and going to 109, as you jog up and down the driveway. (Can you count higher?)</li> <li>• Count backwards by 1s from 50, while hop up and down the driveway.</li> <li>• Count by 2s starting at 1 and going up to 41, while you sit and alternate touching your toes.</li> <li>• Count by 2s to 100 while you take giant steps up and down the driveway.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Art – Something Special For Mom or Grandma</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On a walk look for some good sized rocks you can paint and decorate and then write the words Mom, Nana or Love on.</li> <li>• Find some scrap paper and material you could use to make a collage. Outline the shape on a sheet of paper first: flowers, heart, butterfly, Using the paper or material, glue it in to the shape you made to create the picture. Add background and details when you are done.</li> <li>• Create a painting or drawing, use what you have. It could be an outdoor scene or something special they like. Add details. Give for Mother’s Day.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Math – Card Game – Play with your family.</b> <b>Go Fish – Facts for 11 – Ways to make 11</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A good way to work on math facts!</li> <li>• Each player gets 8 cards.</li> <li>• All the others are spread out in the middle face down.</li> <li>• Players match up cards in their hands that are facts for 12. When you put them down say the fact – Ex. <math>5+6 = 11</math>, <math>9+2=11</math>, <math>2+9=11</math>, <math>0+11=11</math>.</li> <li>• Face cards: J-11, Q + K- Miss a turn.</li> <li>• On your turn ask another player for a card you need to make 11. If they don’t have it, go fish! When you put your pair down, say the fact for 11.</li> <li>• For J-11, you don’t need a card, but say <math>11+0=11</math> or <math>0+11=11</math> when you put it down.</li> <li>• First person to match all cards to make 11 wins!</li> </ul>	<p><b>Word Work Game – Play With Your Family</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How many words can you make out of the words: <u>Happy Mother’s Day</u></li> <li>• Set a time: 15-20 minutes.</li> <li>• Write down all the words you can make using those letters.</li> <li>• Remember that every word we write, has to have a vowel in it.</li> <li>• Sometimes you can make a new word by adding a different ending of the word; /s/ /ed/ /er/.</li> <li>• When time is up, take turns reading out your words. Who had the longest word? Did anyone have words no one else came up with?</li> <li>• Whoever has the most words wins!</li> </ul>	<p><b>Build/Make/Writing - Mother’s Day Hanging or Sign.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is a template on the site you can use or create your own. (Could use craft sticks if you had them instead of paper.)</li> <li>• The top board on the sign says: What I Love About Mom/Nana....</li> <li>• On each of the 5 boards under write down one thing you love about your mom: Good cook, Plays with me etc...</li> <li>• Cut out the sign picture and glue it to a piece of construction paper or cardboard.</li> <li>• Colour and decorate each board and the top and bottom board too. Draw pictures around it.</li> <li>• Use string or yarn, cut a piece to glue or tape to the back of each corner at the top, so it can hang. Give for Mother’s Day.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Writing/Art – Make A Mother’s Day Card</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is a card template with pictures you can use added to the site or choose your own idea.</li> <li>• Fold a sheet of construction paper in half. On the front glue the Happy Mother’s Day colouring page or write it yourself. Colour and decorate the front.</li> <li>• Inside – On one side glue the writing page and write a note for your mom or grandma.</li> <li>• On the other side glue the picture frame page and make your own picture adding good details. Colour and decorate. Sign your name on the card.</li> <li>• Give it to mom or grandma for Mother’s Day.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Writing/Word Work/Art</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write an Acrostic Poem – A poem where the letters of each line spell out a word or sentence about the topic.</li> <li>• Think of a word or sentence about your mom or grandma for that starts with each letter going down.</li> <li>• There are idea templates on the site or create your own. Decorate and colour.</li> </ul> <p>M__ N__ * Give to your mom or grandma O__ A__ for Mother’s Day. M__ N__ A__</p>	<p><b>Math – Measurement – Non-Standard Units</b></p> <p>* Non-standard units are not real units of measure. Today you are going to use a pair of your shoes to measure. * How many shoes long is it? Before you measure you are going to estimate. Remember an estimate is a good guess. Look at the item, look at your shoe: Record your estimate. * Measure: bed, table, door, step, tub, TV, fridge, car, carpet/floor. Make sure you don’t leave spaces between your shoes when you measure. Record the measurement. *What was the longest? What was the shortest? *There is a sheet added to the site or you can make one. *Why would we not use shoes to measure a book?</p>
