Reading Comprehension Strategies



- When we read we learn new things about the story or book we are reading.
- We find out information about the topic that we can use to answer questions or retell the story.
- Here are some strategies you can use to help make sure that we understand what we read and to help when you are doing reading comprehension.
  - 1 Read the story more than once. Sometimes we miss things the first time. 2. Ask questions as you read and predict what you think might happen next. 3 After each page or part of the story stop and retell: Who and What. 1) Who or what did I read about. 2) What were they doing? 4 Make a picture in your mind of what you are reading. Infer - Sometimes they do not tell the exact 5. answer, but they give clues or key words to what they are saying or talking about. After you are done reading, retell the story 6. to someone else.
    - 7. Read over the questions about the story. Go back and find the answer in the story and underline or highlight it.
