Grade 2 - Home Learning Week 3 Pack - January 24th - January 28th

- Please find included materials and activities that can be used for Week 3.
- As well the students would still have the original Home Learning Kit that went home at the beginning of the year that can be used for extra activities and math games, should you need them.

Reading

- It is very important that students keep up with their reading and continue to read every day.
- There are 4 levelled books and a log sheet (Just in case the other one is full) in the reading bags.
- Students can read the books more than once.
- They can also read books from home, or ones sent in the first kit.
- Read books on-line Tumble Books The link is on the class page.
- Poems These are good to work on fluency.
- Make sure you record all books read on the log sheet.
- Choose 1 book to read each day

Writing

- There are 2 writing activities to work on over the week
- Writing/Art Winter Poster There are instructions on the back of the sheet.
- Winter Opinion Writing Which Sport Do You Prefer? There are directions on the back of the sheet.
- We often take 2 or 3 days to work on a piece of writing, depending on what it is. It does not have to be done in one day. You can spread it out over the 2 weeks.
- Remember to begin and end sentences the right way. Start with a capital and end with (?/./!).
- Tell good details about the topic. A sentence tells a whole idea.
- Use the word sheets in this pack and your Home Learning Kit to help.

Word Work

- There is a new set of spelling words for this week. We are on Week 9 The focus is on the long /a/ vowel that says its own name and the bossy /e/ on the end that is silent.
- Go over the words each day and practice them.
- There is a test sheet that you can do on Friday. Have someone at home call out the words and you can spell them on the sheet.
- There are 3-word work activities for the week that use the spelling words or the long /a/ vowel sound. One is a word search; one is a colour by spelling word. The ither is a sheet with a little story to read and then highlight the /ake/ words in the story. Answer the questions below the story by circling the right answer. Remember the answers are in the story.
- The 8 Sight Word lists are important for the students to know and help with their reading and writing skills.
- You can continue to work on these lists if there are some that you do not know yet.
- These sheets are in the Home Learning Pack that was sent home at the beginning of the year.

Math

- We have been working on adding and subtracting using strategies, counting in different ways, and counting with money, showing numbers in different ways.
- The activity pages for math include these outcomes. There are 3 sheets for the week.
- One is a colour by code. Solve the number sentences first. Put your answer in the space, then use the colour code to find out what the picture is. This one is on subtraction.
- There is a sheet on counting by2s to 50 by colouring the right number path and quick doubles.
- One sheet involves showing the number 45 in different ways. We have used tens and once, odd, and even, place value rods and units, tally marks, more and less.
- Remember to use your strategies when you are working on the pages.
- There are 4 new BUMP games in the pack. You can use the counters that were sent in the last pack, and I am sending 1 more dice, as some of the games need 2 dice. One of them uses a deck of cards, and you can find this in the Home Learning Kit I sent home at the beginning of the year.
- Just a reminder that included in the Home Learning Kit, that was sent home at the beginning of
 the year is a sheet with different card and dice games you can play, along with a deck of cards
 and dice.

Winter Poems

- We have a poetry book at school, so I have added 6 winter poems for the students to read.
- These can be added to the reading log too, if you would rather read the poems than a book one day.
- Feel free to colour the pages too.

Homework Books

- I have included another week in the pack. Please put this in the orange homework books.
- This has the spelling and reading, along with a math, word work or writing activity for each day.

There is a Word Work and Math activity sheet for each day, between the Homework Book and the sheets in the Pack, and 2 writing activities for the week.
