<p>Create a scavenger hunt for your family. Hide things around your home and write clues to help them find the items.</p>	<p>Write an Easter story using some of the words below: Easter, bunny, basket, egg, chocolate, chick</p>	<p>At Easter time we think about rabbits. Draw a rabbit to go with your story.</p>
<p>Draw an oval shape  on a piece of paper and cut it out. Make an ABC pattern on your shape to create your own Easter egg. Tell someone what your pattern is. Hang it in your window.</p>	<p>Practice counting by 2's to 50 and 5's to 100. Try counting by 1's from 0-100 and 100-0. Practice counting with Jack Hartman. Go to his youtube channel: https://www.youtube.com/user/JackHartmann</p>	<p>Play the card game "10 Up" with your family. This is much like 7 Up only you will use 10 cards arranged in a 10 frame- (5 on top and 5 on the bottom) We have played this at school and the children really enjoyed it. Have fun! *Find the rules for playing 7Up below.</p>
<p>What do you love most about spring? Write about your favourite springtime activity. Now go outside and do it. Have fun!</p>	<p>Easter is almost here. Draw an Easter picture or make an Easter card for someone special. Use your sight word lists to help you.</p>	<p>The Easter Bunny left 16 coloured eggs on your step. Show someone how you can share the eggs in as many ways as you can. How many ways did you think of? Draw a picture to show your work. Ex. 2 groups of 8.</p>

Choose 2-3 ideas from above to do each week. Read and/or be read to each day. Review your sight word lists and practice printing the words. Go to your Dream Box account and practice your Math skills.

Weather permitting play and explore outside daily.

Rules for 7 Up- 2-4 for players. The dealer deals each player seven cards in a row face down. Put the remaining cards in a face down pile in center. Players take turns flipping one of their 7 cards, if the card is an ace to seven of any suit, keep the card and put them in order (Ace is one, seven is seven). If the card is not a number 1-7 then flip it over face up. If you turn a card 1-7 and you already have one of those numbers then discard the card. Players keep picking cards until a player flips all of their 7 cards up.
