- *This week we will continue to work on making 10. Watch our bowling video. We throw 3 balls in total and write the new number sentence for 10 each time. Now you give it a try. How many ways can you make 10? There are 2 separate attachments (created by other teachers) that you can print to record your number sentences- one for K and one for Gr. 1. OR you can record your bowling just like we did in the videos.
