Play Wild 8's Math Game--For 2 or 3 players- Only use cards 1(Ace)- 8.

Each player gets 8 cards. • All the other cards are spread out in the middle face down. • Players take turns making partners of 8. If player 1 has 2 cards in their hands that are facts for 8, they play the cards saying the fact out loud. Ex. 1 and 7 is 8, 2 and 6 is 8. For the number 8 you can put down that card and say 0 and 8 is 8 or 8 and 0 is 8. • If on your turn you can't make partners of 8, you can ask the other player for a card you need to make 8. If they don't have it, go wild, and pick a card from the center! If the card you pick helps you to make partners of 8, then play your pair,
