<p>Create a <u>TIC TOC TOE</u> game with your weekly sight words! When it is your turn, say the word and use it in a sentence before putting an O or X on it.</p> <p>You can do it outside with chalk or in the house on paper.</p>	<p>Describe a friend in your neighbourhood and write what they look like, what they like to do and draw them. Then call them up and try to have a conversation in French with them!
