- 1. <u>Sound of the week: " un (um)"</u> Students can listen to the sound of the week and sing along! The action is to put your hands over your eyes looking for anything approaching.

They can also read this book online to work on food vocabulary. At the end of the book, ask your child if tomatoes are a fruit or a vegetable. Get them to reread the book and name any fruit they see or vegetable.

- Math: Students are to continue skip counting by 5s and 10s to 100. Also skip counting by 2s to 20. This week there is also a focus on sorting 2D and 3D shapes. I have included some printable lessons.

- 4. <u>You and Your World</u>: Try to create a collage of the 4 food groups by cutting out the different foods out of food flyers or magazines!
- <u>Fruits et legumes</u> (fruits and vegetables)
- produits céréaliers (Grain products)
- Lait et substituts (Milk and substitutes)
- viandes et substituts (Meat and substitutes)

Try labelling them in French and then putting a price for each. Then, add the prices all up in each food group! Which food group has the highest amount? Which food group has the lowest amount? I have also attached a few printables for food games, students can use as well!
